## Discover Castellón on two wheels

Castellón boasts a wide range of possibilities for bike lovers. It has four BTT (mountain bike) centres, providing information of more than 350 kilometres clearly signed, where cyclists will find equipment and additional support services.

There are routes for every level of expertise, from beginners and families, to demanding routes that require proper physical preparation.

C It is worth mentioning the "Transcastellón Route". Being 512.20 kilometres long and with an accumulated slope of 12,150 metres, it offers a circular route in several stages throughout the province. The route is designed for each cyclist to create their own customised route, setting the distance they want to travel and the town from



which they want to depart.

If the goal is to practice road cycling, Castellón is the perfect setting for cycling tourism, a type of activity increasingly enjoyed with the whole family.

Castellón offers 31 cycling routes for all levels of physical preparation. It is

worth taking the "Ruta del Azahar", an itinerary that crosses the province from north to south bordering the coastline. The route has a high level of difficulty not because of its slopes or mountain passes—the road is practically flat throughout the route—but because of the 130 kilometres that await cyclists who dare to do it.





The province of Castellón is the perfect sports venue, as it brings together all the necessary ingredients—weather, nature, landscapes, services. It is only necessary that the traveller is eager to get to know this land in a different and respectful way. Surely you will return home with the backpack full of Mediterranean sensations.



The best way to reach Castellón is via its airport, which is located close to the main tourist destinations of the province and just one hour from the city of València. It is a modern and comfortable infrastructure, where check-in and boarding are quick and easy, providing free parking for its users.
